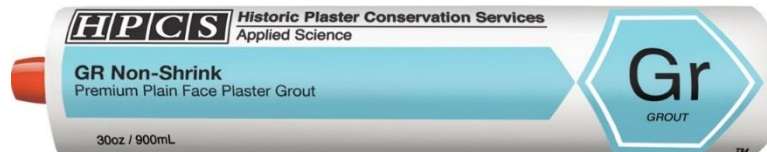

**GR Non-Shrink™ &
GR Non-Shrink Ultra-Fine™**



After consolidation, GR Non-Shrink Grout is used to fill any space that exists between plaster and substrate. Its non-shrink characteristic is essential for applications in which the stress of shrinkage will produce alligator cracks in delicate plaster - an important consideration where surface decoration is present. Comes in a specially designed two-chamber mixing cartridge and with a reusable mixing wand – both are patent pending.



After consolidation, GR Non-Shrink Ultra-Fine grout is used to fill in fine cracks and voids that may exist between the plaster and its substrate. Used for gaps under 3/16". Injection with pistol grip syringe makes application convenient and accurate. Excellent for filling cracks in cast plaster ornaments.
